



Dear Mr. Durazo:

On March 25, 2004, the Santa Clara County Committee on School District Organization approved a citizen's request to transfer two parcels from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts.

Education Code Section 35710 requires that I call an election on this transfer of territory to be conducted at the next regular election. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with all the specifications of the election. The Order of Election is attached.

Ballot Measure

The question to be placed on the ballot is complete and worded pursuant to Education Code Section 35762; there is no additional text. Words on the ballot used for voting on the transfer of territory should be:

For the transfer of territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts – Yes

For the transfer of territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts – No.

Arguments For and Against the Measure

Pursuant to Education Code Section 35758 the county superintendent of schools is responsible for having the arguments for and against the ballot measure prepared and distributed. The argument shall not exceed 500 words.

The argument in favor of the recommendation must be prepared by the president of the county board (county committee) or by a proponent of the recommendation designated by the president.

The argument against the recommendation must be prepared by a member of the county board (county committee) who voted against the recommendation or, if no member is opposed, by an elector designated by the county superintendent of schools (county committee chair) who has appeared before the board or at a public hearing in opposition of the recommendation.



Background

On September 30, 2003, the Santa Clara County Office of Education received a citizen's request proposing a transfer of territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts (as described by the attached map). This request to reorganize school districts is pursuant to California Education Code Section 35700.

The request was determined to be sufficient pursuant to California Education Code Section 35704.

Two public hearings for the proposed transfer of territory, pursuant to California Education Code Section 35705, were conducted on December 3, 2003 and December 10, 2003. At the public hearings, Union School District and Campbell Union High School District, affected districts in the area proposed for transfer, both stated opposition toward the proposed transfer of territory.



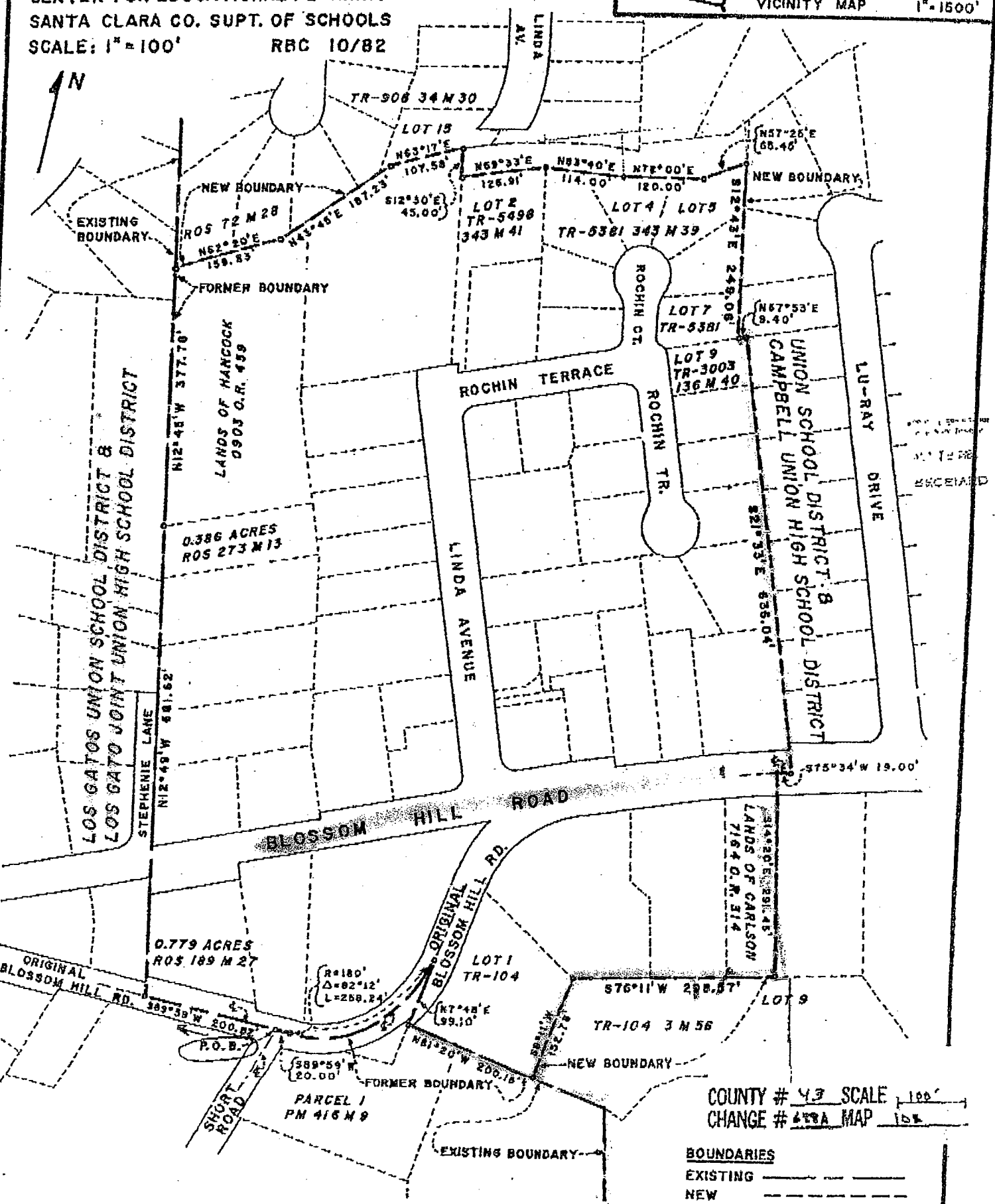
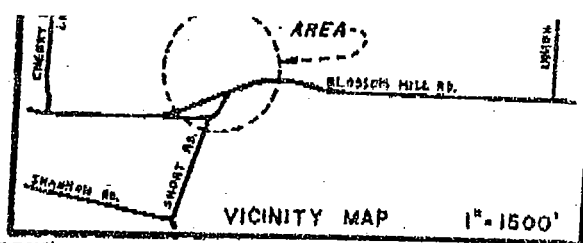

Order of Election from Colleen B. Wilcox, Santa Clara County Superintendent of Schools to Jesse Durazo, Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters requesting services provided by the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters Office regarding the General Election for November 2, 2004.

Purpose: To present the proposition of transferring territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts.

Specifications of the Election Order

- a) The election shall be held on Tuesday, **November 2, 2004.**
- b) The purpose of the election is to present the proposition of transferring territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts.

- c) Words on the ballot used for voting on this proposition shall be:

For the transfer of territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts – Yes

For the transfer of territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts – No.

- d) The election area shall be the territory proposed for transfer (15810 and 15790 Blossom Hill Road, Los Gatos - APN 527-07-005 and 527-07-006).
- e) Pursuant to Education Code Section 5302 and Elections Code Section 10402, the proposition to transfer territory from Union and Campbell Union High School Districts to Los Gatos Union and Los Gatos-Saratoga Joint Union High School Districts shall be consolidated with the November 2, 2004 general election.

By authority granted by Education Code Sections 5302 and 35710, I, Colleen B. Wilcox, Santa Clara County Superintendent of Schools, do order the above described election and will deliver two copies of this order to the Santa Clara County Registrar of Voters not less than 123 days prior to the date set for election.
