#### **Submission of Argument**

Elections Code § 9501 states that the governing board of the district or any member or members of the board authorized by the board, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of such voters and associations may file a written argument for or against any school measure.

Elections Code § 9501.5 states that a ballot argument shall not be accepted unless accompanied by the printed name and signature or printed names and signatures of the person or persons submitting it or, if submitted on behalf of a bona fide organization, the name of the organization and printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers.

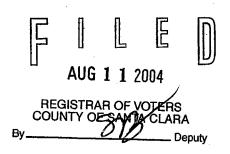

If taxpayers vote money without demanding accountability, they will only get more wasteful spending and low performance. If Silicon Valley companies had raised their expenses every year and attained just fifteenth rank in the world, they would drive our valley out of business and drive everyone to ruin. Yet our public schools are primarily responsible for our fifteenth rank in the TIMMS tests. "More money" they always beg, yet they don't give results to prove that this money is well spent.

Rather than giving them a blank check and a blanket endorsement of their misbehavior, we should tell our state servants to consider reforms that save considerable money: hiring more affordable non-union workers and teachers—especially highly qualified teachers with advanced degrees, firing incompetent teachers more easily, bidding freely on maintenance services, etc. These are not politically-correct reforms, but they would improve school performance while saving costs.

The greatest savings, of course, would come if we gave responsibility for our children's future back to the parents who brought these children into the world. Educational choice would lower costs by letting parents bid for school management that gives better results for lower costs. Simultaneously, it would increase satisfaction by letting parents choose the education they most want: Catholic, Protestant, Jewish, secular college prep, gifted, etc. As Americans, we should know that one size does not fit all.

Bonds disguise the costs of government. If this is regular spending, why not be responsible enough to call for increased taxation—and lower interest costs—rather than use bond spending for things the district should just do with its regular funds. Vote NO: tell the politicians to offer more freedom if they demand more funding.
