In Favor of Measure J

Seven years ago our community approved Measure B – a plan to repair and renovate Santa Clara Unified elementary schools. Using Measure B funds and additional funds from the state, these renovations were completed on time and on budget. Local children are benefiting from upgraded classrooms and facilities and our schools are now ranked among the best in the state.

Measure __ has been placed on the ballot to complete the renovation of all of our local schools, which are 40-60 years old, by upgrading our community's middle schools, high schools and adult education.

Specifically, Measure __ will:

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- Make seismic upgrades to classrooms and schools for earthquake safety
- Upgrade deteriorated restrooms, plumbing, and sewers
- Repair/replace leaky roofs
- Replace inefficient heating and ventilation systems
- Improve electrical capacity and access to technology
- Rehabilitate outdated classrooms, science labs, libraries, and school facilities
- Upgrade building exteriors and grounds for safety

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All Measure __ funds will stay in our community, benefiting local students and schools. By law, every Measure __ dollar will go directly into critical facility upgrades.

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Measure __ will qualify our community for up to \$27 million in State matching funds. Without Measure __, these funds will go to other school districts.
