State cutbacks have forced **EVERGREEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT** to reduce its budget. Without additional funding, our schools face major cutbacks in essential programs, including teacher and staff layoffs, loss of class size reduction, closure of school libraries, and less money for books and technology.

Yes on Measure N provides local funds for our neighborhood elementary and middle schools. Unlike most school funding, money raised by Measure N cannot be taken by the state. Every dollar will stay in our community and will be used to maintain and protect vital school programs.

Yes on Measure N is supported by parents, teachers, business and community leaders who know successful schools will keep our community strong.
