

**Sunnyvale School District  
Official Rebuttal**

We strongly disagree with the opponents' argument against Measure P. None of the opponents lives in Sunnyvale or has visited our aging school facilities.

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Consider the facts:

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FACT: Sunnyvale's elementary and middle schools are 40 to 60 years old and need essential repairs to provide a safe and functional learning environment for students.

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FACT: The Sunnyvale School District has earned the community's confidence by being frugal with taxpayer dollars and completing the first phase of school renovations on time and under budget.

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FACT: Measure P will only fund essential repairs to complete renovations to existing schools. It will replace aging gas, water and sewer lines; improve and expand school libraries; replace outdated heating and cooling equipment with energy efficient systems; build permanent classroom facilities to replace portable classrooms; and expand school facilities to relieve student overcrowding. Measure P funds can only be used for these specific projects - as listed in the measure.

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FACT: An independent citizens' oversight committee will ensure that all funds are properly spent.

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FACT: By law, Measure P funds can only be used to upgrade school facilities, not for salaries or administration.

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FACT: All funds from Measure P will stay in Sunnyvale to improve our aging neighborhood school facilities. The cost of Measure P is deductible on your state and federal income taxes.

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Students and teachers in our community deserve safe and sound school facilities.

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Please join parents, teachers, seniors, local business leaders and others residents in voting Yes on Measure P for our local schools.
