


Elections Code § 9501 states that the governing board of the district or any member of members of the board authorized by the board, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of such voters and associations may file a written argument for or against any school measure.

Elections Code § 9501.5 states that a ballot argument shall not be accepted unless accompanied by the printed name and signature or printed names and signatures of the person or persons submitting it or, if submitted on behalf of a bona fide organization, the name of the organization and printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers.



State law already guarantees that at least 40% of California's general funds are spent on public schools. Furthermore, Franklin-McKinney School District also receives federal grants, corporate contributions, developer fees, state grants, and proceeds from school fund-raisers and foundations. And don't forget the lottery. More responsible spending is needed, not more taxes.

Now is the wrong time to acquire a site, and construct and furnish a new school at Communication Hill. Why add new facilities, and the associated upkeep costs, when the current facilities can't be adequately maintained?

Now is also the wrong time to heighten financial burdens on already struggling property owners.

Our families and seniors are struggling with the rising cost of housing, gasoline, food, dental and medical expenses, child-care and electric

Do we really need a new tax that we, our children, and their children will be paying for the next 30 years?

Although Measure Q taxes property owners, only district residents are eligible to vote (how would you feel if taxed yet DISENFRANCHISED?). It's wrong to vote for increasing the tax burden when you aren't the one paying the tax!

Homeowners are on a property taxing merry-go-round (counties, schools, libraries, fire protection, hospitals, parks, etc.). How many "different" taxes are necessary?

Enough is enough!

Maintenance is part of the district's duties. Responsible owners repair their property when needed.

There are only three voter positions when it comes to taxes:


- 1. Taxes are too high.
