The Franklin-McKinley School District (FMSD) is committed to providing quality education in a safe learning environment. In order to provide our students with school facilities comparable to other Santa Clara County school districts, major repairs, upgraded classrooms and school construction are necessary.

Every school will receive necessary repairs and upgrades from Measure Q. Projects include:

- Repair and/or replace deteriorating plumbing and restrooms.
- Replacement of aging HVAC systems with energy efficient units.
- Repair and upgrade deteriorating/aging roofs as necessary.
- Upgrade electrical systems, including panels, circuit breakers transformers wiring and outlets in classrooms and libraries to accommodate current and future technology/phone access.
- Construction of an elementary school to reduce overcrowding.
- Safety improvements including bus unloading zones and student drop-off areas.
- Upgraded intercom systems at all school sites.
- Upgrade/replace classroom fire/smoke alarms/sprinkler/security systems to meet current code compliance requirements.
- Provide additional classrooms to accommodate enrollment.

Taxpayer Protection

By law an Independent Citizens Oversight committee will be established to ensure that Measure Q funds will ONLY be used for the work spelled out in the ballot. No funds can be spent on administrator salaries. An independent CPA firm will audit the bond funds annually.

There are more than 9800 children in our school district. They need a good education today to meet tomorrow's challenges. They need your help. On November 2nd, please vote YES on Q to repair/upgrade and construct local schools.



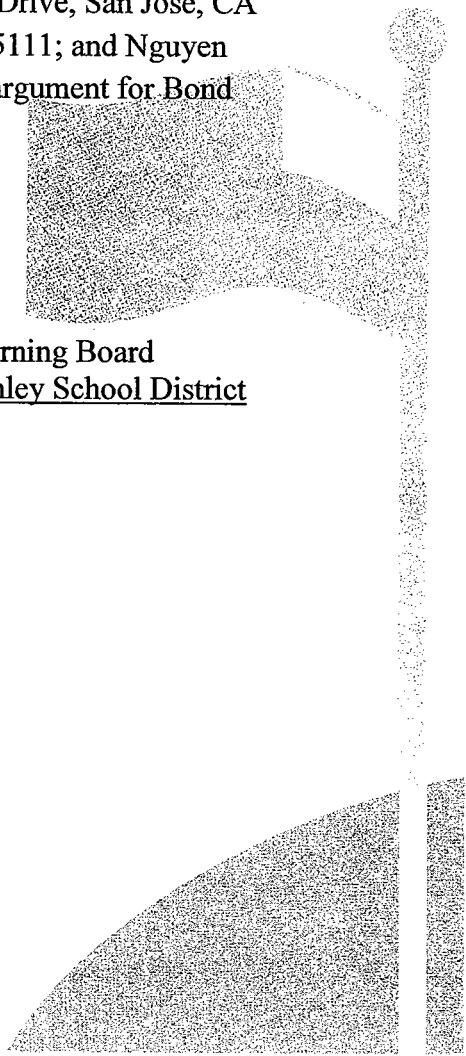
