Argument Against Measure U (City of Saratoga, November 2, 2004 Election)

Before voting for this advisory measure, read the fine print: the measure is NON-BINDING. This means the City could spend the funds any way it chooses. Although this measure emphasizes infrastructure improvement and repair, the City Council may choose instead to allocate the funds to fill expensive management positions at City Hall. ⁵³

One doesn't have to look very far to see how easy it is to do this. When the economy slowed down, the Valley Transportation Authority spent funds raised by a tax measure on day-to-day operations, despite an advisory measure passed by the voters that specified that the funds be spent on transportation improvements. ⁵⁵

This advisory measure promises that the utility tax revenues will be spent on improvements for Saratoga's infrastructure, but offers no incentive to deliver them. ²⁴

Hold the City accountable: Vote NO on Measure U.
